

## Chestnuts Nursery



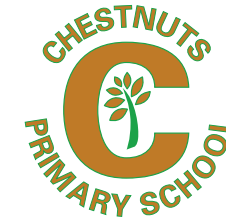
This week our topic is Treasure! There will be sand and water play, treasure hunts, making our own maps, making pirate ships and much more. Say Arrrrrrgh!

And we would love to find an individual or group, willing to organise the Bric-a-Brac stall or Karaoke Dress Up hut.

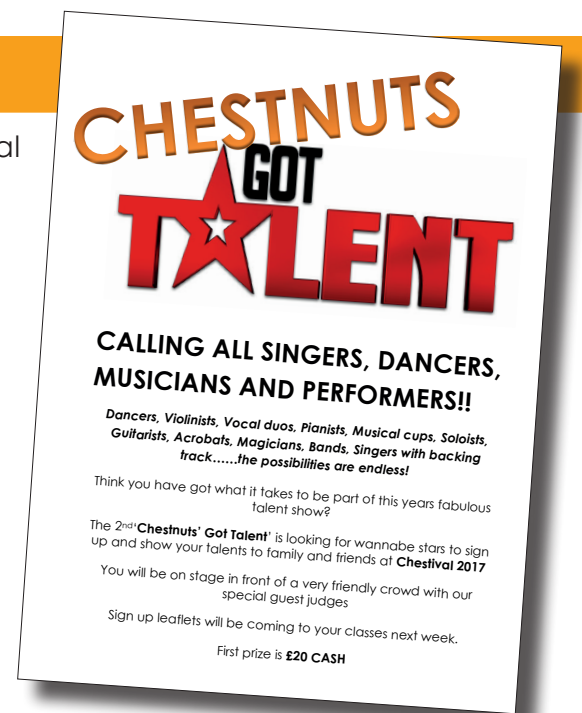
We will again be running the ever popular, Chestival's Got Talent! More details are in this newsletter.
