Shirley Thompson will visit our School

Shirley Thompson OBE is an English composer, conductor and violinist. Her output as a composer encompasses symphonies, ballets, operas, concertos, and other works for ensembles, as well as music for TV, film, and theatre.

In 2002 she composed a symphony called "New Nation Rising" making her the first woman in Europe to have composed and conducted a symphony within the past 40 years. She is also an academic and is currently Reader and Head of Composition and Performance at the University of Westminster. In the 2019 New Year Honours she was appointed an Officer of the Order of the British Empire (OBE) for services to Music.

We are very proud to have named one of our classes after this amazing woman and we are very excited that she is coming to visit our school on Thursday 21st November.
