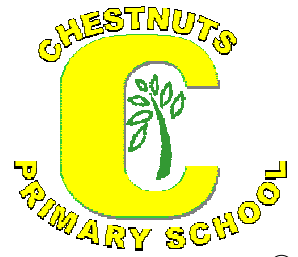

We have written down the estimated sitting times for each class to give you an indication of when you can expect to eat. **The time stated is the earliest time that we expect to go into the lunch hall; this is the ideal time for you to arrive.** But please do be patient as it is likely that you may not actually reach the dinner hall until later than this- the children are going to be very excited and will probably take longer than usual to eat their lunch.

## Social Media Reminder

Many of you will know that over the last few weeks we have been reviewing and tightening up our procedures and practices around the school's engagement with social media. The Governors and I take very seriously our duties of protection for our staff, children and school reputation. Whilst we clearly appreciate that many of our parents and friends use social media in an everyday social context we would ask you to always think very carefully before posting comments or images that relate to the school, our staff or any of our children. Please remember that we are protecting the identity of some of our children hence pictures of children, other than your own child, should not be posted. If you have concerns or comments about your child's education this is always best shared face to face or via closed email directly with the your child's class teacher. We strongly believe that our staff should not be exposed to professionally negative comments on social media and will take action to protect them. Teachers are always keen to talk to parents and allay your concerns swiftly. You can make appointments via the school office, by contacting teachers directly on email or talking to them at the end of the school day.



## Headteacher Recruitment Update

Since my last update at half term, the Governing Body have continued plan and prepare for the upcoming headteacher recruitment. As a reminder of the timetable, our advert will be published over the Christmas holidays and we will then be running tours for prospective candidates during the first couple of weeks of January. Interviews will take place towards the end of January, which means that (assuming we find the right candidate) the new headteacher will start at Easter.

I am also pleased to announce that we have recruited Maureen Duncan as an Interim Executive Headteacher for the Spring term. Maureen has previously held a number of leadership roles, including headteacher, at various London special schools. We have appointed Maureen for two days a week to work alongside Carole Newton (who will be Acting Headteacher) and Sandy McNicholl (who will be acting Deputy Headteacher) during the Spring term. Maureen will be coming in to some of the Christmas events over the next couple of weeks to meet as many of our children and parents as possible before she starts in the New Year.

Finally, thank you to all those who participated in the consultation on the draft Vision Statement. Your feedback has helped us to develop the Vision Statement and will help to inform the headteacher recruitment process. We will publish the final Vision Statement soon.
