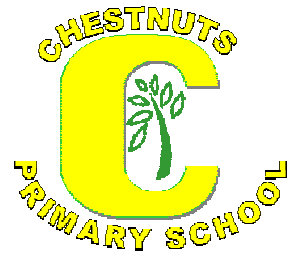

Dear Parents, carers and children

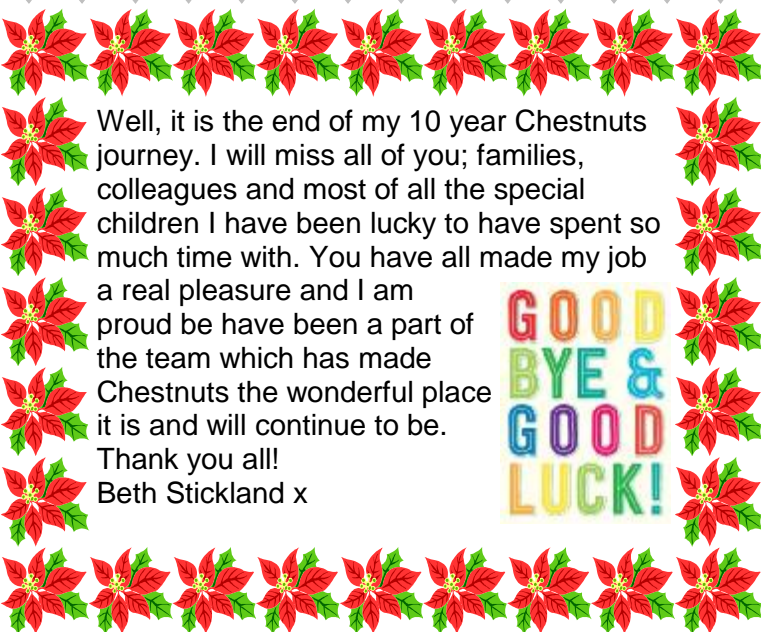

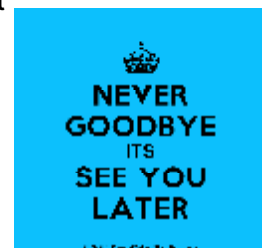
