At 10:45 at Nursery (if your child is block 2 please bring them at 10:30am)

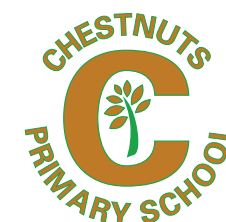
We will then go to Chestnuts Park for our picnic.
