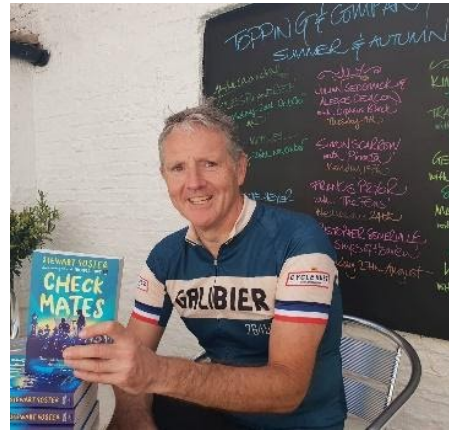




**World Book Day** is an annual celebration of books, reading and stories!
